- tracing **not** required
- use directly for cutting
- fill w/color or patterns for printing
- quality maintained at any size

embroidery formats DST, EXP, PES, JEF & XXX can be opened in DE Plus or BE

.gsp only works in the SD's or Cameo 1's SD slot
