

Print Then Cut on Colored Cardstock

With DS3 the registration "marks" changed to a "box". Using the Design Space file below allows for print then cut on non-white cardstock using the new registration box.

Instructions:

- Cut and paste the Design Space File name above into your browser.
- Cut the file. (Heavyweight cardstock or posterboard works best).
- Position the four guides onto your printed sheet. The narrow side of the sheet should be placed toward the middle of your printed paper.
- Tape the guides to your sheet. (Or, cut these guides and run them through a Xyron with a "repositionable" adhesive to make them easily reusable.)
- Feed into Cricut and cut as normal
